Open up your garden - serve teas and coffees or fruit juice for a donation. You could even organise a few games to liven things up.

Pub quiz or Karaoke night - to finish off a hard day of cleaning up why not ask your local pub to organise a quiz or karaoke night? The entrance fees can make up your donation.

Get sporting - finish the day with a game of cricket, five-a-side or touch rugby. Charge a small entry fee and the winner gets a prize.

Rubbish Art - after a good clean, of course, use some of the more interesting pieces of rubbish you find to make arts and craft items that you can give as gifts and donate your savings or even sell to friends and family for donations.

Spring Clean Easter Egg hunt - add a chocolaty incentive to your clean up by mixing it up with an Easter egg hunt.

Spring clean your house and garden - we all have stuff lying around we no longer want or use, so why not spring clean your stuff and sell it on for donations? You can organise a garage sale, bring and buy or even sell it on eBay and donate some of your profits. Just Google "eBay for charity" and select Keep Scotland Beautiful as your chosen charity.
